Reimagine Recovery Response


CARES Act – May* 2020 - \$33M

- PPE Supplies 
- Paying on enrollment during closures
- Provider emergency operation grants

CRRSA – April* 2021 - \$93M

- Paying on Enrollment vs. attendance 
- Expanded eligibility for front line workers
- Provider operational grants – reopen & sustain capacity

ARP – August* 2021 - \$365M

- Provider operational grants – sustain & improve 
- Family financial support to recover & return to work
- Workforce retention and expansion
- Business supports and automation
- Long-term sustainability of early learning programs
- Equitable access to quality providers that meet needs of all families
